

# Collage Clutch/Crossbody Bag Project

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## Supplies

Fabric 1 (exterior) : Assortment of fabric scraps in random shapes and sizes

Fabric 2 (interior) : 1/3 yard of cotton quilting fabric

Fabric 3 (for the strap) : 1/8 yard of cotton quilting fabric

\*yardage requirements are an estimate, based on 44" wide cotton quilting fabric.

19" x 11 1/2" (48.5 x 29.5 cm) batting

1/3 yard fusible woven interfacing - Pellon SF101 (20" wide) <https://tidd.ly/3BPWzDF>

1x all purpose zipper at least 8" (20 cm) long

1 set of magnetic snap closure 18mm <https://amzn.to/36mRCqk>

1/8" or 1/4" basting tape <https://amzn.to/3BPXtjx>

### **\*if opt adjustable strap**

1/2" (12mm) inner measurement d-rings 2x

1/2" (12mm) inner measurement swivel hooks 2x <https://amzn.to/3CJ2GcJ>

1/2" (12mm) inner measurement adjustable strap slider <https://amzn.to/3BPQ0Rr>

## Tools

Basic sewing & quilting notions

Walking foot

Zipper Foot

Finished bag measurements :  
Approx. 9 1/2" x 6 1/2" (24 x 16.5 cm)



Abbreviation  
FWI : Fusible woven interfacing

## Cutting

### Exterior Panel

Arrange Fabric 1 pieces (fabric scraps) on the batting to create the collage patchwork as demonstrated in the video tutorial.

Trim the panel to measure **18" x 10 1/2" (45.7 x 26.5 cm)**

### Interior panel

Cut 1x from Fabric 2 : 18" x 10 1/2 (45.7 x 26.5 cm)

Cut 1x from FWI : 17" x 9 1/2 (43 x 24 cm)

### Zipper pocket panel

Cut 1x from fabric 2 : 9" x 13 1/2" (23 x 34 cm)

### Slip Pocket panel

Cut 1x from Fabric 2 : 9" x 10 1/2 (23 x 26.5 cm)


### **\*If opt for adjustable strap**

#### Strap

From fabric 3: 55" x 2" (140x 5 cm)

#### d-ring tabs

Cut 2x from fabric 3 : 2" x 2" (5 x 5 cm)



## Directions

Seam allowances are **3/8" (1cm)** unless otherwise stated.  
Please watch the **Full Video Tutorial** for thorough demonstration.

## Bag Exterior

1. Arrange Fabric 1 pieces (fabric scraps) on the batting to create the collage patchwork as demonstrated in the video tutorial.  
Trim the panel to measure **18" x 10 1/2" (45.7 x 26.5 cm)**.

## Bag Interior

2. Fuse the FWI on the wrong side of the interior panel (center the position).
3. Sew and install the zipper pocket.
4. Sew and install the slip pocket.

## If Opt adjustable strap (step 5,6,12)

5. Sew and install the d-ring tabs at the bottom of the interior.
6. Sew the adjustable strap, then install the hardware.

## Closure

7. Install the female magnetic snap on the lower exterior panel; measure 3 1/4" (8.3 cm) from the bottom (center) exterior.
8. Install the male magnetic snap on the upper interior panel; measure 1 1/4" (3.2 cm) from the top (center) interior.

## Assembly


9. With the bag interior and the bag exterior facing right sides together; make sure that the bottom exterior (where the female magnetic snap is located) is facing the bottom of the interior (where the slip pocket is located), sew all around, leaving about 4" of opening at the bottom.
10. Turn the bag inside out through the bottom opening, press.
11. Fold the raw edges of the bottom opening, clip, then topstitch the bottom edges.

12. Fold the d-ring tabs towards the exterior side, then stitch along the edges to secure them in place.

## Finishing

13. Measure 4 1/2" (11.5 cm) from the top edges of the bag, mark on both sides.
14. Fold the the bottom edges of the bag towards the 4 1/2" (11.5cm) mark, clip to secure the fold.
15. Sew the sides and topstitch the flap of the bag (when sewing the sides, reinforce the upper and the lower edges with back stitching).
