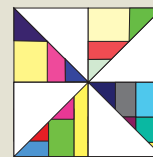


The Crazy Scrap Quilt - Pinwheel Edition Pattern

Fabric Requirements

(based on standard 44" wide cotton quilting fabric)

- Assorted fabric scraps enough to make (18x) 13" square blocks
- 2 1/6 yard background fabric
- 2/3 yard border fabric
- 5/8 yard binding fabric
- 77" x 77" Batting
- 4 1/2 yard backing fabric

Additional Supplies:

Basic sewing and quilting notions

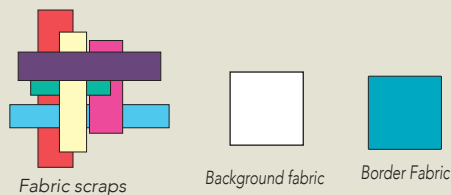

Finished quilt measurements 74 1/2" x 74 1/2"
Seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise stated

Abbreviation

HST : Half Square Triangle

WOF : Width of fabric

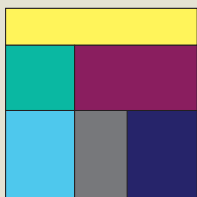


Cutting

1. From the background fabric cut (18) 13" x 13" Squares
2. From the border fabric
cut (2) 69 1/2" x 3" strips (B1)
cut (2) 74 1/2" x 3" strips (B2)

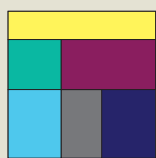
Making the blocks

1. From the fabric scraps make in total of 18 (13" x 13" scrappy blocks).

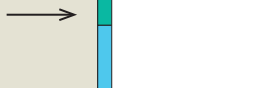


Example of the scrappy block (make 18x)

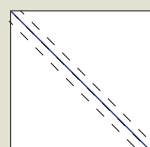
2. Make (2) HST blocks from one scrappy block and one background block.



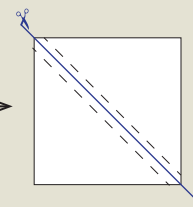
Take 1 scrappy block and 1 background block



Stack them right sides together

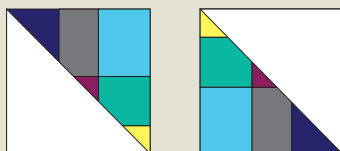


draw a diagonal line,
sew 1/4" from the diagonal line
(both sides)



cut on the diagonal line

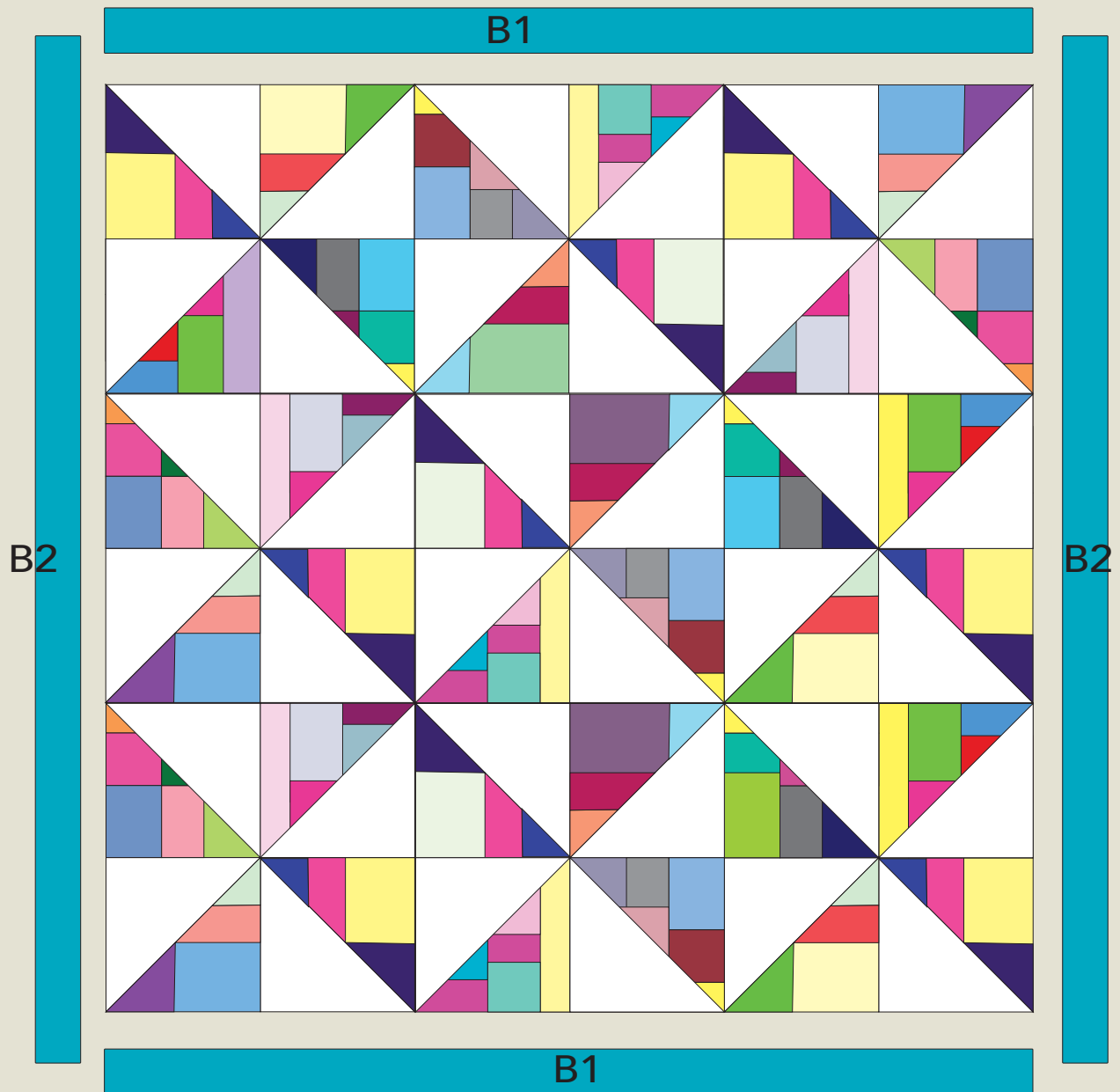
Trim the HST blocks to measure
12" x 12"
make in total of 36 HST blocks

Assembly

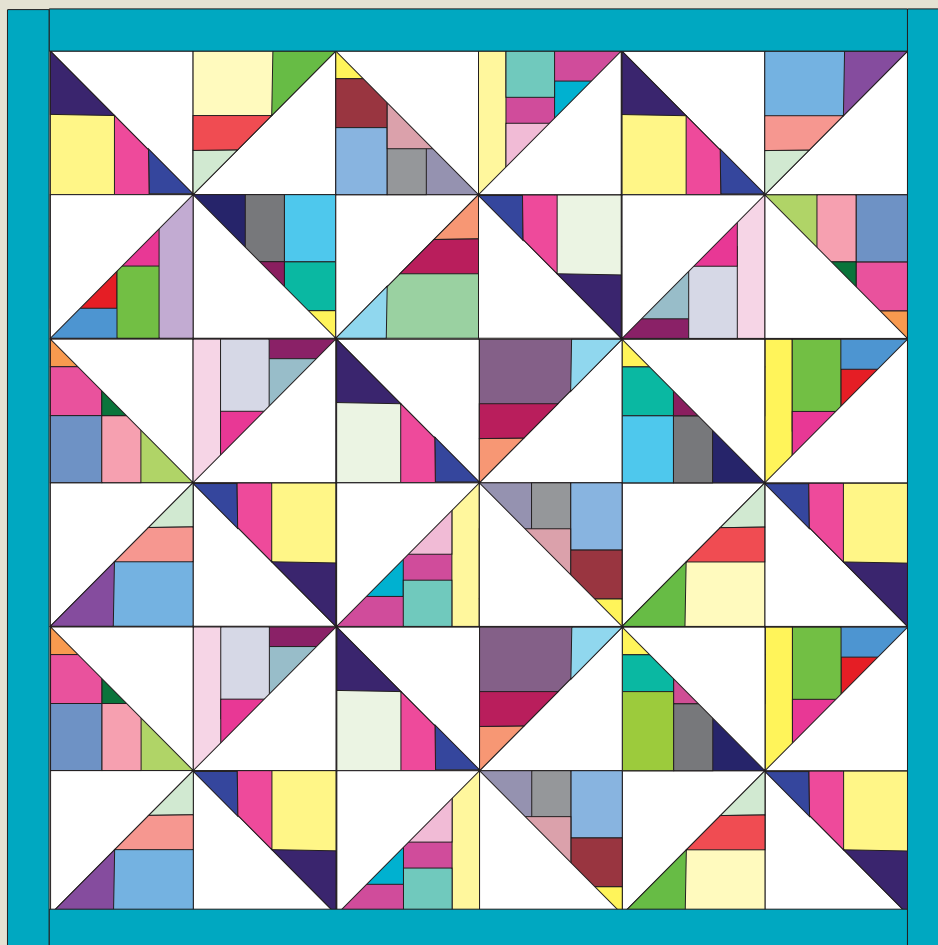
1. Following the below diagram, layout all 36x HSTquilt blocks then sew the quilt center.
2. Sew B1 (shorter borders)
3. Sew B2 (longer borders)

1. Layer with batting and backing fabric
2. Quilt and bind as desired
