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# Supplies

# Fabric/Cutting

#### Unlined version

Main Fabric: cut (1) 5 1/2" x 5 1/2" (14 x 14cm) Swivel hook tab: cut (1) 2" x 1/2" (5 x 1.2cm) \*Suggested fabric choice: cork, faux leather, leather

#### Lined version

Exterior Fabric: cut (1) 5 1/2" x 5 1/2" (14 x 14cm) Lining Fabric: cut (1) 5 1/2" x 5 1/2" (14 x 14cm)

Fusible woven interfacing: cut (1) 5 1/2" x 5 1/2" (14 x 14cm) - apply only if using cotton guilting/lightweight cotton as the exterior fabric, fuse to the wrong side

of the exterior fabric.

Swivel hook tab: cut (1) from the exterior fabric 2" x 2" (5 x 5cm)

\*Suggested fabric choice (exterior): cotton quilting/lightweight cotton, canvas, linen, denim. Suggested fabric choice (lining): cotton quilting/lightweight cotton.

Finished pouch measurements approx. 4" w x 2" d x 1" h 10 x 5 x 2.5cm

#### **Features**

Zipper closure Swivel hook tab

Seam allowances are 3/8" (1cm) unless otherwise stated

# Zipper, hardware

Nylon coil zipper at least 7" (18cm) long, 11/4" (32mm) wide; size #5 or #4.5 1/2" (12mm) inner measurement swivel hook

## Other

1/8" or 1/4" basting tape Polyester thread

## **Tools**

Sewing machine, basic sewing notions

#### **Directions**

Seam allowances are 3/8" (1cm) unless otherwise stated.

Please watch the Full Video Tutorial for thorough demonstration.

- 1. Mark/snip the center point on both side edges of the main panel.
- 2. Attach the swivel hook tab on the right side of one side edge (on the center point mark) of the main/exterior panel.
- 3. Install the zipper, making sure that the start of the zipper is installed on the same side as the swivel hook. use 1/4" (6mm) seam allowance when sewing the zipper.
- 4. With the main panel facing wrong side out, match the side edges of the zipper to the center point mark of the main panel (right sides together), pin.
  - At this point make sure to unzip the zipper at least half way.
- 5. Sew the side edges. If working on the lined version, finish the raw edges.
- 6. Box the corners.
- 7. Turn the pouch right side out, and congratulations your lipstick pouch is done.

the start of the zipper should be on the same side as the swivel hook
