

# Patchwork Needle Book Pattern

Skill Level : Advanced Beginner

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**Finished Book Measurements : Approx. 4 3/4" x 5 3/4" (12 x 14.6cm) when folded**

**Features : 4 x slip pockets, 4 felt pages, strap closure**

## Supplies & Cutting

Exterior (patchwork panel) : 28 pieces of 2 1/2" (6.5cm) squares - cotton quilting fabric

Interior : 11" w x 6 1/2" h (28 x 16.5cm) cotton quilting fabric

Batting : 12" x 7 1/2" (30.5 x 19cm)

Pocket : 11" w x 9" h (28 x 23cm) cotton quilting fabric

Strap closure : 2 1/2" w x 31 (6.5 x 79cm) cotton quilting fabric

Felt panel 1 : 9" w x 5" h (23 x 12.5cm)

Felt panel 2 : 8" w x 4 1/2" h (20 x 11.5cm)

## Tools

Sewing machine

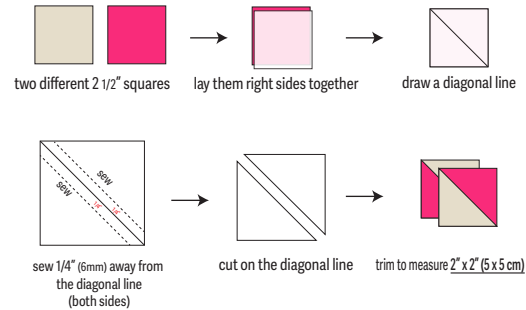
Basic sewing and quilting notions

Square ruler or quilting ruler

1/4" presser foot (optional but recommended)

Walking foot (optional)

## How to make Half Square Triangles



make in total of 28 half square triangles

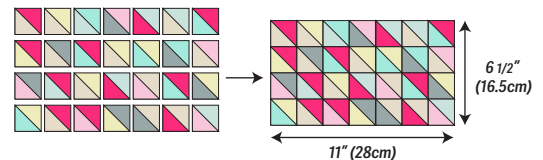

## Instructions (Brief Overview)

Seam allowances are scant 1/4" (6mm) when piecing the patchwork; 3/8" (1cm) when assembling the book.

1. Make 28 pieces of half square triangles - trim each piece to measure 2" x 2" (5 x 5cm)
2. Arrange your half square triangle pieces in 4 rows.
3. Piece the patchwork together.
4. Layer with the batting, then quilt as desired.
5. Trim off excess batting
6. Sew and install the pocket to the interior panel.



7. With the right sides facing sew the exterior and interior panel together. Use 3/8" (1cm) seam allowance. (remember to leave an opening at the bottom).
8. Turn right side out, topstitch.
9. Sew and attach the strap.
10. Attach felt panel 1
11. Attach felt panel 2, and your needle book is done.

### NOTES

1. Instead of half square triangles, you can also use 2" (5cm) squares instead, or simply cut one panel same size as the interior panel.
2. When stitching bulky layer, switch your needle to a larger one (e.g. microtex 90/14 or denim 100/16 and increase the stitch length).
3. Always backstitch in the beginning and towards the end of your sewing to secure the seams.
4. Always use disappearing fabric marker when marking on the fabric.
