
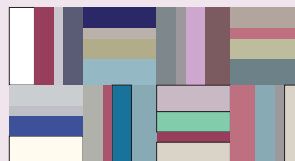


Spring Casserole Quilt Pattern

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Supplies

Various scraps and left over fabrics

estimated yardage

Fabric 1 : 1 1/8 yard

Fabric 2 + 4 : 1 5/8 yard

Fabric 3 : 1/2 yard

69" x 77" batting

4 2/3 yard backing fabric

2/3 yard border fabric

1/2 yard binding fabric, or use 7x Jelly roll strips

Note :

yardage requirements are based on 44" wide standard cotton quilting fabric

Finished Quilt measurements approx. 62 1/2" x 70 1/2" (158.7 x 179 cm)

Seam allowances are 1/4" (6mm)

1. Cutting

From your fabric scraps cut the following (56x each)

Fabric 1 : 8 1/2" x 3 1/2" (21.5 x 8.5 cm)

Fabric 2 : 8 1/2" x 2 1/2" (21.5 x 6.4 cm)

Fabric 3 : 8 1/2" x 1 1/2" (21.5 x 3.8 cm)

Fabric 4 : 8 1/2" x 2 1/2" (21.5 x 6.4 cm)

Border 1 :

From the border fabric make two strips 56 1/2" x 3 1/2" (143.5 x 8.5 cm)

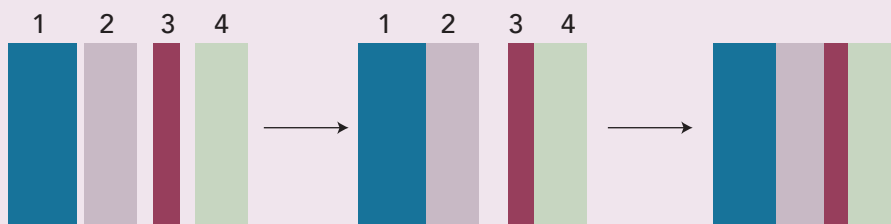
Border 2 :

From the border fabric make two strips 70 1/2" x 3 1/2" (179 x 8.5 cm)

Binding : From the binding fabric cut seven 2 1/2" (6.4 cm) strips;
or use 7x jelly roll strips

2. Making the blocks

Following the below diagram, make in total of 56 blocks.



finished block : 8 1/2" x 8 1/2" (21.5 x 21.5 cm)

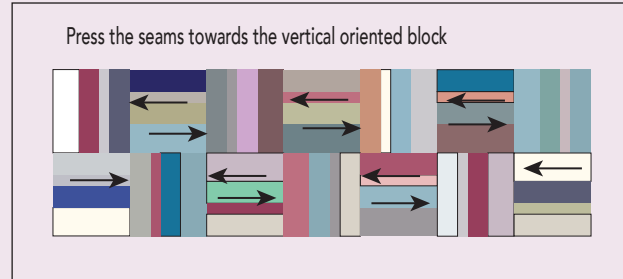
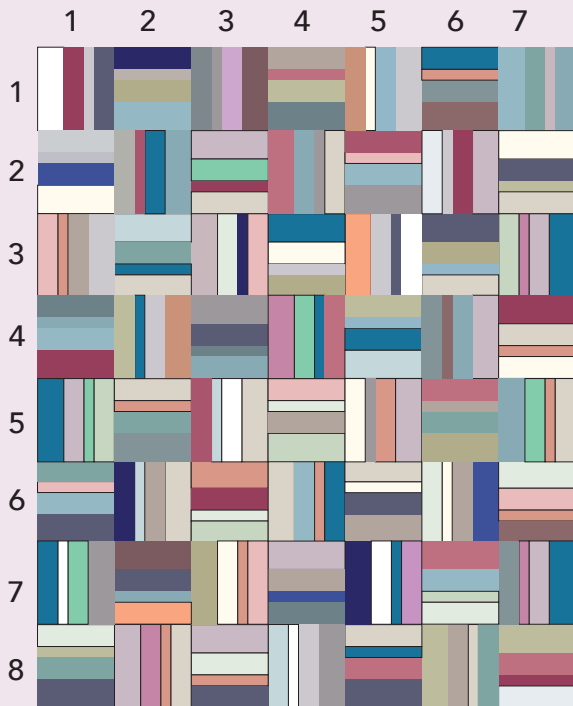
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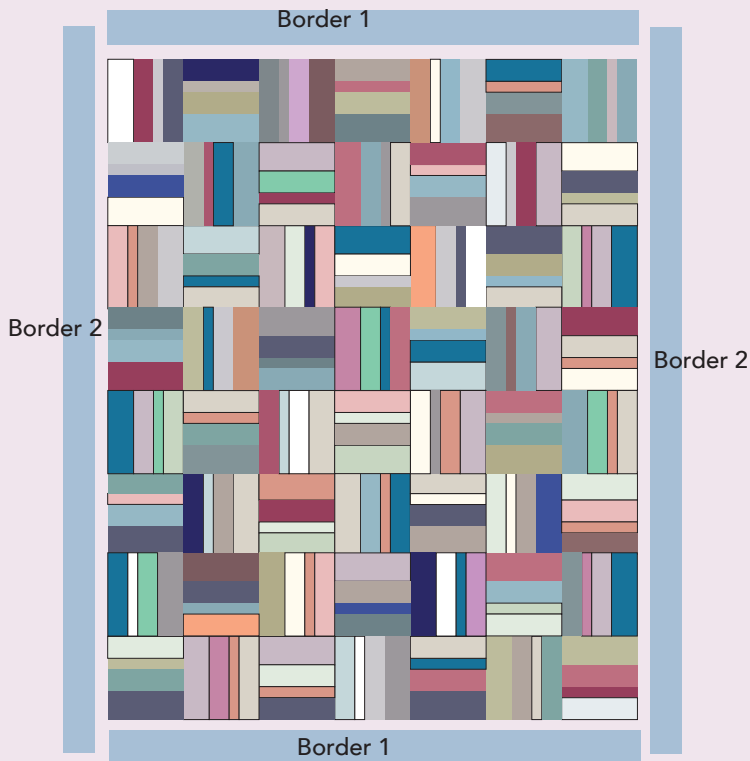
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3. Assembly

Referring to the below diagram, lay out your blocks in 8 rows and 7 columns, alternating the direction of the strips.



4. Sew Border 1, press towards the border fabric.
5. Sew Border 2, press towards the border fabric.
6. Quilt and bind as desired.



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
