

# Surprise me - Wall Hanging Quilt Project

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Finished quilt measurements : Approx. 17 1/2" x 38 1/2" (44 x 96.8 cm)

## You will need :

40x pcs of charm packs, 5" x 5" (12.7 x 12.7 cm) fabric squares. <https://amzn.to/3iAz1te>, <https://bit.ly/3y17NTa>

21" x 42" batting <https://amzn.to/3kSXZxw>

2/3 yard backing fabric

1/6 yard border fabric

1/3 yard binding fabric

*Note: yardage requirements are estimated, based on standard 44" wide cotton quilting fabric.*

Machine quilting thread (if opt machine quilting) <https://amzn.to/36Z6Xuc>

Basic sewing /quilting notions

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Seam allowances are 1/4" (6mm)  
unless otherwise noted

Abbreviation :

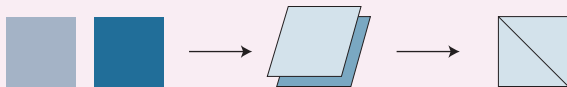
HST : Half square triangle

WOF : Width of fabric

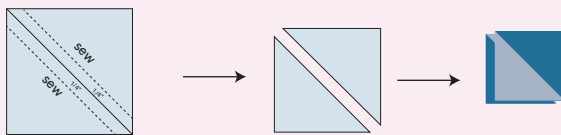

## Cutting/ Making the half square triangles (HST)



two different 5" squares lay them right sides together draw a diagonal line



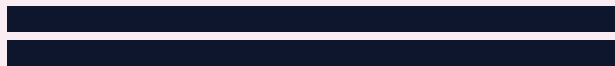
sew 1/4" (6mm) away from the diagonal line  
(both sides) cut on the diagonal line

trim to measure 4" x 4" (10 x 10 cm)

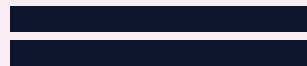
**make in total of 40x hst**

Border 1 : 35 1/2" x 2" (89.2 x 5 cm) cut 2x from the border fabric

Border 2 : 17 1/2" x 2" (44 x 5 cm) cut 2x from the border fabric

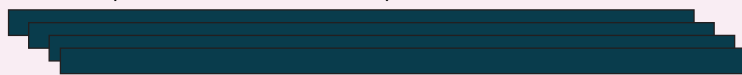


Border 1

Binding strips : cut four 2 1/2" (6.5 cm) strips from the WOF



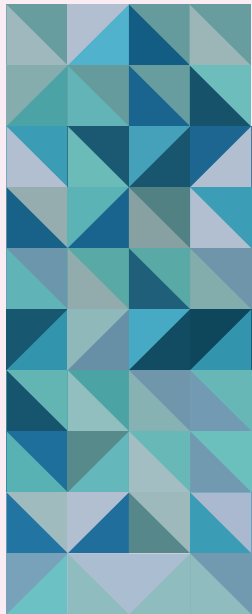
Binding strips

Hanging sleeves :  
6" x 6" (15 x 15 cm) cut 2x

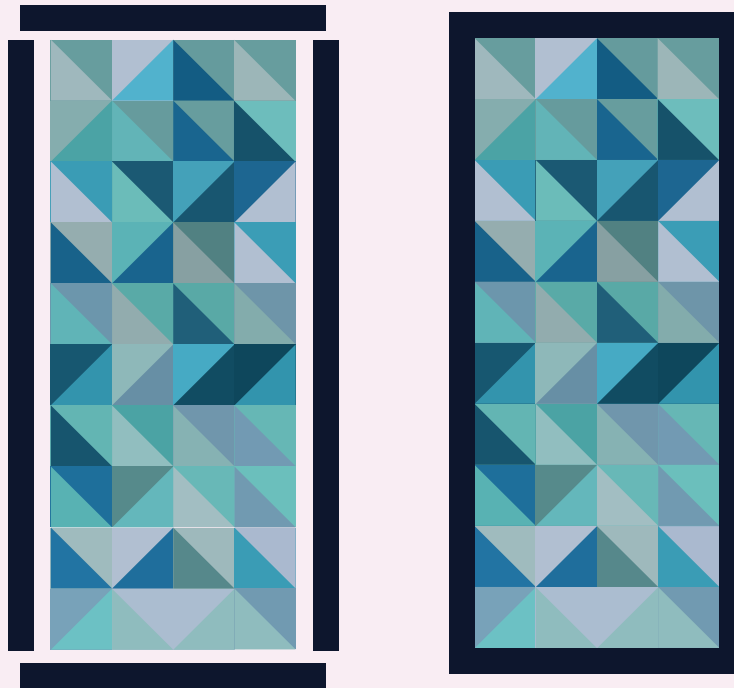


## Assembly

1. Following the instructions in the video tutorial, randomly sew the hst blocks in to create a layout of 10x rows and 4x columns
2. Sew Border 1
3. Sew Border 2



sample layout of my quilt



4. Layer with batting and backing fabric, baste, then quilt as desired.
5. Attach the hanging sleeves
6. Bind with your favorite binding method. You may follow my binding tutorial here : <https://youtu.be/wW5Hc0DrCeg>
7. Your quilt is done, enjoy.
