Supplies and measurements

1x exterior fabric 10 1/2" x 6" (26.7 x 15.2 cm)
1x interior fabric 10 1/2" x 13 1/2" (26.7 x 34.2 cm)
1x batting 11 1/2" x 7" (29.2 x 17.8 cm)
1x fusible woven interfacing 9 1/2" x 12 1/2" (24 x 31.7 cm)
1x 1/4" (6mm) wide elastic 3 1/2" (9cm) long
1x small button 3/4" - 1" (19 - 25 mm) diameter
Basic sewing/quilting notions

Notes

-recommended fabric: cotton quilting, canvas, linen, or any light - medium weight woven fabric -fusible fleece may be used instead of batting, cut one the same size as the exterior fabric

Finished wallet measurements: 3 1/2" x 5" (8.9 x 12.7 cm) when folded



Directions

(please refer to the video tutorial for more detailed instructions).

Seam allowances are 3/8" (1 cm) unless otherwise stated.

- 1. Layer the batting to the wrong side of the exterior fabric, quilt as desired, then trim off any excess batting.
- 2. Fuse the fusible woven interfacing to the wrong side of the interior fabric (center the position).
- 3. Rotate your interior fabric to landscape position, then draw the folding lines as shown below.



- 4. Fold and press the folding lines to create two pleats.
- 5. Topstitch the pleat lines, then baste stitch the short sides with 1/4" (6mm) of seam allowance to hold the pleats together.
- 6. Measure 3 1/2" (8.9 cm) from the side edges, draw a straight vertical line with your fabric marker, repeat the same to the opposite side.
- 7. Sew on the dividing lines to create the tea slots. Trim the bottom so that the interior fabric will measure 6" (15.2cm) tall
- 8. Install the elastic and the button to the right side of the exterior fabric.
- 9. With the exterior and interior fabrics right sides together, sew all around the perimeter (remember to leave an opening at the bottom).
- 10. Clip all the corners, turn your fabric right side out through the opening hole.
- 11. Fold the raw edges of the opening hole towards the wrong side (about 3/8"), clip/pin, or press to hold the fold.
- 12. Finish the wallet with topstitching.
