

# Two-Zipped Key Fob Pouch Project

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Skill level : Beginner Friendly

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## Supplies

Exterior : 6" x 16" (15 x 41cm) cotton quilt weight fabric

Lining : 6" x 21" (15 x 53cm) cotton quilt weight fabric

\*Fabric amounts are approximate—directional prints may require extra.

1x nylon coil zipper at least 6 1/2" (16.5cm) long, 1 1/4" (32mm) wide; size #5 or #4.5 (front)

1x nylon coil zipper at least 5" (13cm) long, 1 1/4" (32mm) wide (back)

1x key fob ring about 1" (2.5cm) diameter

1/8" or 1/4" basting tape <https://amzn.to/3BPxtjx>

Polyester thread

## Tools

Sewing machine, fabric scissors or rotary cutter,

basic sewing notions, zipper foot, clear ruler

Seam allowances are 3/8" (1cm) unless otherwise stated

Finished pouch measurements  
approx. 4 1/2" wide x 3" tall  
11.5 x 7.5 cm

### Features

Two zipper compartments

Key fob ring

Small yet functional

## Cutting Instructions

Following the below chart, cut your fabric and stabilizer accordingly.

Name	Exterior Fabric	Lining Fabric
Front Upper	Cut (1) 5 1/2" w x 1 3/4" h (14 x 4.5 cm)	Cut (1) 5 1/2" w x 1 3/4" h (14 x 4.5 cm)
Front Lower	Cut (1) 5 1/2" w x 3" h (14 x 7.5 cm)	Cut (1) 5 1/2" w x 3" h (14 x 7.5 cm)
Back Left	Cut (1) 4 1/2" w x 4" h (11.5 x 10 cm)	Cut (1) 4 1/2" w x 4" h (11.5 x 10 cm)
Back Right	Cut (1) 1 3/4" w x 4" h (4.5 x 10 cm)	Cut (1) 1 3/4" w x 4" h (4.5 x 10 cm)
Pocket Interior		Cut (2) 5 1/2" w x 4" h (14 x 10 cm)
Ring Tab	Cut (1) 2 1/2" w x 2" h (6.5 x 5 cm)	

### Instructions (Brief Overview)

Seam allowances are 3/8" (1cm) unless otherwise stated.

1. Cut all your pieces.
2. Sew the front zipper pocket.
3. Sew the back zipper pocket.
4. Sew the ring tab, then attach it to the front panel.
5. Assemble the pouch (leave an opening at the bottom).
6. Turn the pouch right side out through the opening hole
7. Hand stitch using slip stitches to close the opening.

### NOTES

- Always **backstitch** in the beginning and towards the end of your sewing to secure the seams.
- Always use disappearing fabric marker when marking on the fabric.
