Fabric	58" (148 cm) wide	44" (112 cm) wide
Exterior	3/4 yard (0.67m)	7/8 yard (0.8m)
Lining	1 yard (0.92m)	1 1/4 yard (1.2m)

The yardage requirements are estimated. More fabric may be needed if using directional print. -Suggested fabric choice (exterior): waterproof home decor, waterproof canvas, cotton laminate. -Suggested fabric choice (lining): Nylon ripstop, PUL fabric.

3 yard (2.8m) webbing strap, 1 1/2" (38mm) wide Nylon coil zipper size #3, 1" (2.5cm) wide; at least 10" (25.5cm) long 1 set of magnetic snap closure (18mm)

1" x 1" (2.5 cm x 2.5cm) fusible stabilizer or midweight interfacing 1/8" or 1/4" basting tape Fabric glue stick Polyester thread

## Tools

Sewing machine, basic sewing notions Zipper foot, Walking foot Seam allowances are 3/8" (1cm) unless otherwise stated

#### **Cutting Instructions** Following the below chart, cut your fabric accordingly. Name **Exterior Fabric Lining Fabric** Front & Back Exterior Cut (2) 16 1/2" w x 15" h (42 x 38 cm) Front Exterior Pocket Cut (1) 7 1/2" w x 9 1/2" h (19 x 24 cm) Cut (1) 7 1/2" w x 9 1/2" h (19 x 24 cm) Side Exterior Cut (2) 7 1/2" w x 15" h (19 x 38 cm) Cut (2) 7 1/2" w x 10" h (19 x 25.5 cm) Side Exterior Pocket Cut (2) 7 1/2" w x 10" h (19 x 25.5 cm) Cut (1) 16 1/2" w x 7 1/2" (42 x 19 cm) Cut (1) 16 1/2" w x 7 1/2" (42 x 19 cm) Bottom Exterior & Interior Cut (2) 16 1/2" w x 3 1/2" h (42 x 9 cm) **Upper Front & Back Interior** Lower Front & Back Interior Cut (2) 16 1/2" w x 12" h (42 x 30.5 cm) Upper Side interior Cut (2) 7 1/2" w x 3 1/2" h (19 x 9 cm) Cut (2) 7 1/2" w x 12" h (19 x 30.5 cm) Lower Side interior Front interior - Slip pocket Cut (2) 16 1/2" w x 10" h (42 x 25.5 cm) Front Interior - Zipper pocket Cut (1) 12" w x 18" h (30.5 x 46 cm) Strap Cut (2) from the webbing strap 53 1/2" (136cm)

Finished bag measurements approx. 15" wide x 13 1/2" tall x 6 1/2" deep (38 x 34.3 x 16.5 cm)

Features

Front exterior slip pocket

2x exterior side pockets Magnetic snap closure

3x interior slip pockets

Interior zipper pocket

## Directions

Seam allowances are 3/8" (1cm) unless otherwise stated. Please watch the <u>Full Video Tutorial</u> for thorough demonstration.

## **Bag Exterior**

1. Sew the front pocket, then attach it to the right side of the front exterior panel.

- 2. Install the straps to the front and back exterior panel.
- 3. Sew the side pockets then install them to the right side of each side panel.
- 4. Assemble the bag exterior.

## **Bag Interior**

- 5. With the right sides facing, sew the upper interior and the lower interior, press the seams open, then top stitch. Repeat to sew the remaining panels.
- 6. Sew the slip pocket then install it to the right side of one interior panel (this will be the front interior panel).
- 7. Install the zipper pocket to the remaining interior panel (this will be the back interior panel).
- 8. Assemble the bag interior, leave about 7" (18cm) of opening at the bottom.

## Closure

10. Mark 1 1/2" (4cm) from the top edge of the front and back interior (centered). Add a piece of stabilizer on the wrong side.

- 11. Install the male magnetic snap to the right side of the front interior panel following the manufacturer's instructions.
- 12. Install the female magnetic snap to the right side of the back interior panel following the manufacturer's instructions.

#### Assembling the bag, finishing

13. With the bag exterior wrong side out, and the bag interior right side out, insert the bag interior into the bag exterior (make sure the front side of the bag interior is facing the front side of the bag exterior and vice versa).

- 14. Pin the top edges, then stitch all around the top.
- 15. Turn the bag right side out through the opening hole.
- 16. Fold the raw edges of the opening towards the wrong side about 3/8" (1cm), pin, stitch along the edges to close the opening.
- 17. Put the lining back inside and congratulations your Waterfront Beach Bag is done.

#### NOTES

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- As always for best results use a **walking presser foot** (except when installing zipper).
- When stitching bulky layer, switch your needle to a larger one (e.g. denim needle size 100/16), and increase the stitch length.
- Always use disappearing fabric marker or chalk marker when marking on the fabric.
